The position requires enthusiasm, a positive attitude, and a collaborative spirit while working in a team setting to support the mission of Howell Nature Center.

### Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age
- Minimum 1 year of relevant teaching experience with diverse audiences (informal, outdoor experience) OR 1 year of college education in biology, ecology, education, or related field.
- Ability to successfully pass background check.
- Ability to lift 10 lbs., walk on uneven trails, and be on your feet for long periods of time.

### General Responsibilities:

- Communicates and demonstrates the organization's mission, goals, and culture in creating a social context of "Heal, Grow, Be Wild!"
- Leads and conducts outdoor programs designed to educate children and adults from diverse backgrounds on ecological and recreational topics in a warm and welcoming manner.
- Maintains program materials and equipment under the Nature Education department.
- Some nights and weekend work may be required.
- Assists in and manages the cleaning and maintenance of buildings, leading by example in our "leave a place better than you found it" belief.
- Maintains professionalism in personal appearance and communication with other staff, chaperones, and participants.
- Attend all meetings, trainings, and events as scheduled.
- Completes other projects and work as assigned by supervisors.
