

Overnight Camp Counselor

Position Description:

- 45 - 55 hours per week
- July 5th - August 12th

Reports to:

- Boys/ Girls Unit Leader, Overnight Camp Coordinator, Manager of Camp and Nature Programs

Compensation:

- \$400-450\$ per week, commensurate with experience

Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age
- Ability to lift 10 lbs, walk on uneven trails, and be on your feet for long periods of time.

General Responsibilities:

- Supports the organization's ethos statement of "Heal, Grow, Be Wild!"
- Along side a team of overnight counselors, this position is responsible for the overnight supervision of 2-20 campers each night
- Develops a personal relationship with each camper and is mindful of each camper's needs.
- Maintains camper's physical and emotional wellbeing at all times.
- Leads activities for groups of 5-15 campers. Activities may include: archery, zip lining, swimming, canoeing, pond study, field games, etc.
- Uses positive behavior management techniques with Campers and models appropriate behavior at all times.
- Treating campers and co workers with kindness and respect at all times.
- Cleans program materials and spaces throughout the day.
- Promote safety and health regulations, following our COVID-19 procedures.
- Guide and encourage individual campers in participation in camp activities.
- Engage in weekly camp themes.
- Assist in and manage the cleaning and maintenance of buildings, leading by example in our "leave a place better than you found it" belief.
- Other duties as needed.
