## **Position Details:**

The Camp Lifeguard provides supervision and ensures a safe environment at the camp's waterfront activities. This position assists in the management to the physical operation of the waterfront facilities and equipment.

- Date Range: June 3rd - August 17th
- Includes evening and weekend shifts

## **Qualifications:**

- Prior experience working with children
- Ability to work outside in direct sunlight and be on your feet for 8-10 hours a day
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds and respond to physical emergencies
- Familiarity with waterfront safety practices
- Current certification in lifeguarding, CPR, and first aid, or willingness to attend a training prior to the listed start date

## **General Responsibilities:**

- Supervise and guard all waterfront activities
  - Provide surveillance during aquatic activities to help prevent and to manage injuries.
  - Provide rescues as needed
  - Utilize first aid and CPR and other emergency management services as needed
  - Understand and implement an appropriate response to changes in water conditions or weather conditions affecting the waterfront
  - Evaluate aquatics abilities of campers and staff
- Assist waterfront instructional staff in program areas such as swimming and boating
  - Ensure campers and staff follow safety procedures while in their program activity
  - Act as reference in waterfront activities
  - Assist in the delivery and supervision of all water activities and special events at the waterfront

## **General Responsibilities (Continued)**

- Assist in the management and care of the physical facilities and equipment in the waterfront program area
  - Conduct daily checks of area and equipment for safety, cleanliness, and good repair
  - Clean waterfront area daily keeping it free of hazards and debris
- Other duties as assigned

## **Reports to:**

- Director of Overnight Camp, Director of Day camp, Waterfront Director

- Stipend of \$440 per week
- Training pay: \$220
